

Suggested Problems to Use in Preparing for the Final

For material from the first half of the course, use the review sheet from the midterm for suggestions on review. For reviewing the material since the first midterm, the following problems in Kennedy provide practice for some of the types of questions that will be asked on the final. The answers to all of these questions are in the book.
